### **CCSSE** - Promising Practices Items

Before conducting the ANCOVA analyses, the promising practice variables were recoded into new dichotomous variables indicating whether a student participated in the practice or not. The new variables were recoded such that the reference group [coded 0 (zero)] consisted of the students who did not participated in the practice. For items where one of the response options was "Not Applicable," students who selected this response option were excluded from the analysis involving that item.

In addition to the SENSE Promising Practices items from the additional question set and the main survey, several other variables used in the models as covariates were also recoded. These variables were defined as dichotomous in the original data set; however, they are recoded here to 0/1 values instead of 1/2 values. The group defined by the zero value is the reference group in SAS PROC GLM. The table below shows how these variables were recoded.

### SENSE variables combined to create analysis variables used in the models.

Some of the constructs in the SENSE survey (e.g., attending orientation) were asked in multiple questions to get a more detailed picture of the students' experiences. However, for the purpose of the analyses conducted for the National Report, we were interested in more general questions (e.g., did you attend any form of orientation), so we created new variables based on responses from multiple variables. The coding logic used to create the new variables is presented below.

The FFTUSE and OLTUSE variables (Items 20.2d and 20.2e, respectively) were recoded into dichotomous variables with the extension \_USED. These recoded variables were then used to determine if a student participated in either face-to-face tutoring or online tutoring and a new dichotomous variable was created:
