What are CCSSE special-focus items?

In order to keep the survey fresh and relevant for the community college field, a special-focus item set is administered each year with *CCSSE*. This enables colleges to more deeply explore certain issues that are key to improved student engagement and success.

All colleges receive the five special-focus items as part of their *CCSSE* administration. Students are asked to mark their responses under "Additional Items" at the end of the <u>survey</u>. The results from these items are provided as frequency distributions with colleges' standard *CCSSE* reports.

CCSSE 2023 items

These items are designed to help your institution gain insight about your students' experiences with career readiness that promotes economic mobility and equity.
