

CCSSE (2005-16) / CCSSE (2017-present) Codebook Crosswalk

Color coding for variable names:

- **BLACK**: no change in the item or the response set from current CCSSE
- **Bold red**: Item wording changed, no matter how minor the change was, or response option wording was changed. A new variable name is assigned.
- **Bold blue**: This is a new item
- **Bold White text on dark blue background**: Item text did not change, but variable name changed.
- **Response Option cells highlighted in yellow** indicate a coding change from the previous version of the survey, regardless of whether the item changed. This, in some cases, is simply a recoding so the response values are more logical (e.g., 1 = Yes, 0 = No [No used to be coded 2]); in other cases, like the items in 12.1, where we changed the response options on the survey, but did not change the items (unless otherwise noted). For part 2 of item 12, the variable names did not change, but the response option codes did change (except for 12.2j and 12.2L where the variable names did change).
