



SOSE / CCSSE Crosswalk

The following crosswalk includes similar items from the Community College Survey of Student Engagement (*CCSSE*) and the Survey of Online Student Engagement (*SOSE*).

CCSSE provides information on student engagement, a key indicator of learning. The survey, administered to a random sample of students at participating institutions, assesses institutional practices and student behaviors correlated with student learning and retention.

SOSE is an online companion to *CCSSE*. *SOSE* helps community and technical colleges gather engagement data from online-only students at their institutions by asking questions that focus on aspects of student engagement in the online learning environment.

For colleges that participate in both *CCSSE* and *SOSE*, or are considering participation in both, this crosswalk provides a mechanism for comparing specific institutional practices and student behaviors for two distinct student populations: in-class students (*CCSSE*) and online students (*SOSE*).
